Section 5. Delinquent Accounts

No new permit will be issued to persons or businesses having an outstanding debt.

Section 7. Posting

The District shall post, in a conspicuous location in each office and website, a complete schedule of all fees and charges. A public hearing announcing proposed new fees or increased fees will be published as required by law and such public hearing be conducted at a District Board of Health meeting.
